

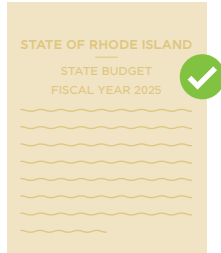
# 2024 LEGISLATIVE RECAP



## \$160 MILLION IN MEDICAID FUNDING

**SUMMARY:** CPNRI's #1 priority this year was clear: Fully fund rate reform passed in 2022. At the beginning of the session, the Governor's proposed budget funded **only** 33% of the recommended rates. By the end of the session 100% was **FULLY** funded. This is the largest single-year Medicaid investment **EVER**.

**WHY IT MATTERS:** A precedent has now been set that the biennial rate reform **should** be funded in full. CPNRI will continue to advocate for rate reform funding to be required and not an option.

## ACCESSIBLE HOUSING

A bill to require universal design (UD) in new affordable housing developments received significant opposition from RI Housing. The bill did not pass. RI Housing did agree to include elements of UD in their design standards. CPNRI remains committed to making progress on accessible housing.



We have made a LOT of progress during the last three legislative sessions and beyond. Disability is truly becoming a bigger part of the conversation at the State House and it is our job to keep this momentum going.
